Claims:	An aid in the treatment of musculoskeletal conditions and soft tissue injuries in horses where anti-inflammatory, anti-pyretic and analgesic activity would be beneficial.
Net Contents:	20 mL, 30 mL, 80 mL, 100 mL, 150 mL, 500 mL and 1L.
Directions for Use:	
Restrictions:	DO NOT USE in food-producing animals.
Contraindications:	This product should not be used in horses with a history of cardiac, renal or hepatic disorders, or when gastro-intestinal tract ulceration or blood dyscrasias are present or suspected. Discontinue therapy if signs of lethargy, colic, diarrhoea, inappetence, oral ulceration or vascular disorders resulting in ventral oedema occur during treatment.
Precautions:	Foals or pony breeds may have a greater risk of toxicity than horses, and care should be taken to adhere to the recommended dose rates in these animals. Therapy in ponies should be discontinued if no response is seen after 4-5 days of treatment. Phenylbutazone should not be combined with other NSAIDs or other highly protein bound drugs, such as digoxin, warfarin and sulfonamides.

Side Effects:	
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Dosage and Administration:	<p>Administer paste orally 30 minutes prior to feeding. Elevate the horse's head and using a suitable dosing syringe, deposit the appropriate dose into the back of the mouth. Keep the horse's head elevated and observe the horse to ensure the dose is swallowed.</p> <p>HORSES 450 kg; 10 mL (2 g phenylbutazone [PBZ]) twice on the first day, then 5 mL (1 g PBZ) twice daily for 4 days, then 5 mL (1 g PBZ) daily or every second day as required or as directed by a vet.</p> <p>PONIES 225 kg; 5 mL (1 g phenylbutazone [PBZ]) daily for 4 days, then 2.5 mL (0.5 g PBZ) daily or every second day as required or as directed by a vet.</p>
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General Directions:	If used in performance animals, regulations of relevant authorities regarding medication should be observed.
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Withholding Periods:	MEAT WITHHOLDING PERIOD (HORSES): DO NOT USE in horses that may be used for human consumption.
